#### NWGA-USBC All-Star Qualifier's Tournament Rules

Entry is open to members of the Northwest Georgia USBC who have bowled a minimum of 12 games in a NWGA-USBC league.

The entry fee is \$70.00 per bowler. *CERTIFIED CHECK OR MONEY ORDER* should be used to pay entry fees. Make checks payable to **NWGA USBC Tournament Fund**. **A \$30.00 ADMINISTRATIVE FEE**, **PLUS BANK CHARGES WILL BE LEVIED ON ANY RETURNED CHECK**. For the Regular Division, \$18.75 per entry will be used to pay lineage and \$11.25 will go to tournament expenses. For the Senior and Super Senior Division \$15.00 per entry will be used to pay lineage and \$15.00 will go to tournament expenses. The remaining fees, including the association share of other income, will be used to pay the entry fees for no more than two teams in each of the State All-Star Tournaments (\$75 Regular and \$65.00 Senior/Super Senior). The remaining funds will be distributed equally among the bowlers of these teams after they participate in the State Tournament.

This tournament will have 3 divisions:

Regular = No age requirements Senior = 50 or older as of February 21, 2026 Super Senior = 60 or older as of February 7, 2026

When registering for this tournament, an eligible participant can choose to enter a 2<sup>nd</sup> and/or a 3<sup>rd</sup> division if they are eligible to bowl in that event at the state level for an additional cost of \$40.00 per event.

The total cost to bowl:

1 event = \$70.00 2 events = \$110.00

Participants may enter up to 1 hour prior to each squad in the order of receipt of entry fee and based on lane availability. Advance entries are encouraged to assure inclusion and may be paid by certified check or money order. Each squad may be limited as to the number of bowlers. Entry forms must include the name of the league and bowling center in which the entrant participates in league play.

This is a Scratch tournament. Regular All Star entrants will bowl five (5) games across 10 lanes. Senior and Super Senior All Star entrants will bowl four (4) games across 8 lanes. The number of teams that NWGA sends to the State Tournament for each of these divisions will be determined by the total number of bowlers participating in each division. A minimum of 12 participants are required to send one team to the State Tournament and a minimum of 20 participants are required to send a 2<sup>nd</sup> team. After all entrants in each division have bowled, the top six qualifiers from each division will represent the association as members of the first team with the next six making up the second team in each of the state tournaments. If there are not enough participants to send at least one team to any of the State All-Star tournaments, NWGA will refund \$35.00 to each participant.

The association will only provide shirts for the members of the top 2 teams for each of the State Tournaments.

If any of the tournaments allow more than two teams from NWGA, members of these additional teams will pay their own entry into the tournament and will receive NO additional funds or shirts from this association.

In the event a bowler cannot participate in the state tournament, alternates will be selected in the order of finish until a team is filled (seventh moves to sixth and 13<sup>th</sup> moves to 12<sup>th</sup>, etc.). In the event of a tie for last position(s), the tied bowlers will drop their lowest game/s until the tie is broken. If a qualifier does not show up at the State Tournament, he/she will NOT be eligible for the next two years but may appeal (in the event of an emergency) to the Board of Directors. The board decision will be final.

USBC playing rules will apply. Protests affecting eligibility or playing rules, must be in writing to the Tournament Supervisor or Manager within seven days of the date games bowled. Errors in scoring must be reported to the Tournament Supervisor or Manager within 24 hours. Rules not covered will be decided by the Tournament Supervisor or Manager and their decision is final unless appealed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.

<u>Dress Code:</u> Participants are expected to wear suitable attire during the competition. All clothes must be neat, clean, and free of holes or frayed hemlines. Acceptable tops include full length shirts or bowling jerseys with polo, butterfly or sash collars, or t-shirts with league logos. Acceptable bottoms include pants, nice jeans, capris, walking/casual shorts, skirts and/or skorts at least fingertip length. Attire or equipment depicting alcohol, illegal substances, gambling, or inappropriate language/gestures is forbidden in accordance with USBC Rule 103b. Tournament officials will determine the appropriate attire, and those decisions are final.
