The Mac Liddell Senior Handicap Tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress. The tournament shall be governed by the following rules and all other USBC rules pertaining to certified competition.

- 1. Entry into the Mac Liddell Senior Handicap Tournament is open to all current members of the Northwest Georgia USBC Association who have bowled a minimum of 21-games in a NWGA-USBC Association League this current season and who have reached their 50th birthday prior to the 1st squad on December 6, 2025. The tournament shall consist of a doubles event, singles event and optional All-Events Scratch & Handicap. Three games shall be bowled in each event and total pins, including handicap shall decide the winner. The total of six games bowled shall determine the All-Events winner.
- 2. In singles & doubles there will be separate divisions for each of two age groups
 - a. Class A (60 +) & Class B (50 thru 59), Women's division & Open division
 - b. In doubles events, bowlers will be classed by the age of the youngest bowler.
 - c. A male and female bowling as doubles partners will be classed in the Open division.
- 3. Entering Average:
 - a. Highest regular or substitute 2024-25 certified (Winter Season) average (based on at least 21 games), regardless of association.
 - b. If no previous season average, use highest summer League average of at least 21 games as of the end of the 2025 Summer league. Verification of such an average (Signed by the League Secretary) must be submitted with entry.
 - c. If no Summer League average, use the highest current certified league average of 12 or more games as of November 18, 2025. Verification of such an average (Signed by the League Secretary) must be submitted with entry.
 - d. If none of the above applies, the entrant must bowl scratch and the entering average will be 210 (USBC Rule 319b).
 - e. If an average other than 2024-2025 Yearbook (or www.bowl.com) average is used, the bowler must provide verification from League Secretary or a standing sheet.
 - f. USBC Rule 201a (Average Conversion) WILL apply.
 - g. USBC Rule 319a/2 (Ten-pin Rule) and 319e (Use of Tournament Average Rule) will NOT apply.
 - h. USBC Rule 319d (Reporting Prize Winnings) WILL apply.
 - i. Tournament management will decide any question not covered by these rules. Their decision is final unless appealed in accordance with USBC Rule 329.
- 4. CERTIFIED CHECK OR MONEY ORDER should be used to pay entry fees. Make checks payable to NWGA USBC Association Tournament Fund. A \$30.00 ADMINISTRATIVE FEE, PLUS BANK CHARGES WILL BE LEVIED ON ANY RETURNED CHECK.

Entries open as soon as entry forms are available. Reserved entry closing date is midnight November 8, 2025. Entries postmarked the first post office business day following the closing date will be accepted. Entries will be scheduled according to request based on lane availability. The tournament manager may accept walk-in entries up to 1 hour prior to a squad based on lane availability. A walk-in fee of \$5.00 will be assessed per bowler/per event.

- 5. **Re-entry** will be allowed (based on lane availability).
 - a. Singles may only cash one time (Rule 315c)
 - b. In Doubles, a bowler may cash only once with the same partner but may cash multiple times with different partners. (Rule 315b/2)
 - A bowler may enter All Events only once and the first scores bowled in singles and doubles will be used for the All Events scores. (Rule 315d)
- 6. Substitution will be allowed when necessary. A substitute form must be presented to the Tournament Director one (1) hour before the scheduled time. The substitute must bowl in the replaced bowler's spot. Replacements will not be eligible for All Events prizes unless they replace the same bowler who has entered All Events and bowl in both Doubles and Singles.
- 7. If the participants choose to bowl both Singles & Doubles events in one squad, the Singles event will be bowled first followed by doubles on the same pair of lanes. If a bowler's partner has not arrived by the time the Singles Event has been completed, and a substitute is not available, the bowler will be permitted to bowl games in the Doubles Event to qualify for All Events. When a doubles team is scheduled by itself on a pair of lanes, each member will complete the frame on one lane before starting its next frame. NO PACERS SHALL BE PERMITTED.
- 8. Handicap is based on 90% of the difference of entering average and 210. It is the responsibility of the entrant to verify the accuracy of their average (USBC Rule 319a/3).
- 9. All prize money will be returned 100% in the event collected. Prize money will be awarded one for each eight (8) entries in each event, by division, and by class, including All Events. Ties for first place will result in Co-Champions and the prize money for the number of teams tying for First Place will be combined and divided equally and duplicate awards will be presented. If a tie exists for other than first place, the prize money will be combined and divided equally among the tied position winners. Award checks will be void after 60 days.
- 10. Dress Code: Participants are expected to wear suitable attire during the competition. All clothes must be neat, clean, and free of holes or frayed hemlines. Acceptable tops include full length shirts or bowling jerseys with polo, butterfly or sash collars, or t-shirts with league logos. Acceptable bottoms include pants, nice jeans, capris, walking/casual shorts, skirts and/or skorts at least fingertip length. Attire or equipment depicting alcohol, illegal substances, gambling, or inappropriate language/gestures is forbidden in accordance with USBC Rule 103b. Tournament officials will determine the appropriate attire, and those decisions are final.
- 11. Only participants and tournament officials are allowed in the playing area. Food, beverages, and smoking are not allowed in the playing area. Smoking is governed by the bowling center, state and local laws. These regulations must be observed in the bowling center.
