RULES FOR THE NWGA USBC ASSOCIATION YOUTH LEADERS, OFFICERS & VOLUNTEERS TOURNAMENT

The NWGA USBC Association League Officers Tournament is certified by the United States Bowling Congress. The tournament shall be governed by the following rules and all other USBC rules pertaining to certified competition.

ELIGIBILITY

Entry in the Northwest Georgia (NWGA) USBC Association Youth Leaders & Officers Tournament is open to all current officers, board members and auxiliary members of the NWGA-USBC Association Youth Leaders, Youth Bowler of the year winners and individuals that have volunteered to assist the Northwest GA USBC Association are also eligible to enter. Participants must be a member of the Northwest Georgia USBC Association, Inc. The Tournament shall consist of a 3-game doubles handicap event contested in one (1) division.

HANDICAP & AVERAGES

Handicap for the League Officers Tournament will be based on 100% of the difference between the highest average of the individual and 220.

Averages will be accepted in the following order:

- A. Entrants will use their highest regular or substitute 2024-25 certified (Winter Season) average (based on at least 21 games), regardless of association. (USBC Rule 319a/1a)
- B. If no previous season average, use the highest current league average of at least 21 games as of **January 1, 2026**. <u>Verification of such an average (Signed by the League Coordinator) must be submitted with entry</u>.
- C. If there is no current season average, use the highest summer league average of at least 21 games as of the end of the 2025 Summer league. <u>Verification of such an average (Signed by the League Coordinator) MUST be submitted with entry.</u>
- D. If none of the above applies, the entrant must bowl scratch and the entering average will be 220.
- E. Youth standard averages may be used.
- F. USBC Rule 201a (Average Conversion) WILL apply.
- G. USBC Rules 319a/2 (Ten-pin Rule) and 319e (Use of Tournament Average Rule) will **NOT** apply.
- H. BOWLERS ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR VERIFYING THEIR OWN AVERAGES. (USBC Rule 319a/3)

ENTRY FEES

The entry fee will be \$13.50 per bowler to cover lineage. No fees shall be refunded after entries have been received and the dates assigned by the Tournament Director and have been accepted by the Team Captain.

CERTIFIED CHECK OR MONEY ORDER should be used to pay entry fees. Make checks payable to MWGA USBC Association Tournament Fund.
A \$30.00 ADMINISTRATIVE FEE, PLUS BANK CHARGES WILL BE LEVIED ON ANY RETURNED CHECK.

Entries open as soon as entry forms are available and reserve entries will close January 4, 2026. Walk-in entries will be accepted until one (1) hour prior to the start of a squad **if lanes are available**. A walk-in fee of \$3.00 will be assessed per bowler.

PRIZES

Prizes will be in the form of scholarships and provided by the NWGA USBC Association for the highest scores in each division listed below. An individual is eligible for only one prize. Duplicate awards will be given for ties.

DIVISIONS

Doubles Handicap — Open Division

PARTICIPATION

Entries will be scheduled according to request if possible, and in the order received. The Tournament Director, except for an emergency, will not change the schedule. The Tournament Director will assign lanes for each event. The lineup will be the same as shown on the entry form. Any player or team arriving after the game has started will be allowed to bowl and the score(s) will count beginning with the frame then being bowled. **No score will be given for frames missed.**

The tournament recap sheet will be the official score sheet. Scores will be verified from the automatic score printouts. Tournament games cannot be re-bowled, except as authorized by the Tournament Manager when scores are irretrievably lost in an automatic scoring device.

Only participants and tournament officials are allowed in the playing area. Food, beverages, and smoking are not allowed in the playing area. Smoking is governed by the bowling center, state, and local laws. These regulations must be observed in the bowling center.

<u>Dress Code:</u> Participants are expected to wear suitable attire during the competition. All clothes must be neat, clean, and free of holes or frayed hemlines. Acceptable tops include full length shirts or bowling jerseys with polo, butterfly or sash collars, or t-shirts with league logos. Acceptable bottoms include pants, nice jeans, capris, walking/casual shorts, skirts and/or skorts at least fingertip length. Attire or equipment depicting alcohol, illegal substances, gambling, or inappropriate language/gestures is forbidden in accordance with USBC Rule 103b. Tournament officials will determine the appropriate attire, and those decisions are final.

SUBSTITUTES

Substitute forms must be submitted to the Tournament Director thirty (30) minutes before the scheduled time. Substitutes **must** meet the eligibility requirements listed above. In case of disability after a game has started, a substitute will be allowed, if one is available. If no substitute is available, only the actual score of the frames bowled will count. A substitute will not be required to reimburse the original entrant with the entry fee paid nor shall the substitute be expected to give the original entrant any prize money or award they may win.

PROTESTS AND APPEALS

Will be governed in accordance with USBC Rule 329

Prizes will be awarded during the NWGA Annual Meeting that will immediately follow the tournament. We hope you will stay to help us make the important decisions for YOUR association!
